



The City of Winchester and the County of Frederick are located at the top of Virginia, only 72 miles northwest of Washington, D.C., 86 miles south of Gettysburg, and 22 miles north of the Skyline Drive and Shenandoah National Park. With seven major roadways – routes 11, 522, 50, 340, 81, 7, and 66 – converging in Winchester, the area is situated within a 3-hour drive to 14% of the U.S. population.
